She has had an amazing experience with "So You Think You Can Dance" making all the way to the top 10 and touring on a 40 city national tour. Randi hopes to pursue her career as a dancer and looks forward to what the future will bring!

Jacki attended the University of Utah on the Willam F. Christensen scholarship and graduated with a performance/teaching emphasis. She has worked with such companies as Ballet West, Utah Ballet, and as a principal dancer with Rocky Mountain Ballet. Jacki has appeared on stage in "Funny Girl", "The Radio City Christmas Spectacular", as a Rockette, "Mack And Mabel" with Jerry Herman, and "Sinatra, His Voice, His World, His Way" with John Pizzarelli. Industrial/Television work includes: IBM, Q-Lube, Polaris, Intel, Tupperware, Wal-Mart, "As The World Turns," Telemucno Upfront", the 2004 Tony Awards, "One Night Only" with Hugh Jackman, The Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade, The Today Show, and Good Morning America. Jacki taught as a guest teacher in Tokyo at the Broadway Dance Center and is currently a guest teacher at Broadway Dance Center and Steps in NYC. Her versatility as a teacher and choreographer keeps her in high demand around the country.

Carol Ravich

Miss Carol Ravich, born in Boston, Massachusetts, was Principal Ballerina with the Boston Ballet Company and has performed as a guest artist throughout the country. Her formal training was with the Hazel Boone School and the Boston Ballet School in Boston. Throughout her outstanding career as a guest artist in the United States Miss Ravich also performed with the Pennsylvania Ballet and Igor Yourskevitch's Ballet Companies. As a guest ballerina with the Boston Opera Company she performed at the White House for President Lyndon Johnson. After moving to Miami, Florida, Miss Ravich established the Ravich Ballet School, and her professional company which performs throughout South Florida. Currently, she is a master teacher, choreographer and a successful coach. Miss Ravich actively trains and coaches dancers for international ballet competitions, as well as staging full length ballets throughout the United States.

Danny co-directs a project entitled "TAP the MAP", where he and two friends drive around the country, hosting "in studio" tap workshops with the hope of keeping the art tap dance alive and thriving. He recently became a member of Brenda Bufalino's "New" Tap Orchestra and will be performing at Lincoln Center and Symphony Space this summer as part of NYC's Tap City Festival!
